

## IS YOUR WORKPLACE SAFE FOR EVERYONE?

### 15 Things you can do to help protect Emergency Services Workers:

1. Install safety railings and guardrails where required.
2. Ensure alarms are functioning properly.
3. Do a hazard assessment – Ask yourself, what could go wrong here?
4. Ensure open holes are covered.
5. Clean up broken glass, spills & debris.
6. Ensure safe storage of hazardous and flammable materials.
7. Store pallets and other stacked materials safely.
8. Install motion sensor lighting.
9. Make sure signage is properly posted.
10. Get permits for **ALL** renovations.
11. Ensure access points to construction sites are clearly marked.
12. Keep hallways and **ALL** exits clear of clutter.
13. **DO NOT** lock, chain or block emergency exits.
14. Yield to emergency vehicles. Check mirrors regularly - Pay attention and pull over.
15. Avoid distractions while driving – **NO** cell phones or texting.
